

## PROGRESS NOTED IN FORD PROJECTS BEGUN AT MOORE'S LAKE

SHOVEL EXCAVATING FOUNDATIONS OF DAM; CONCRETE POURING NEXT WEEK

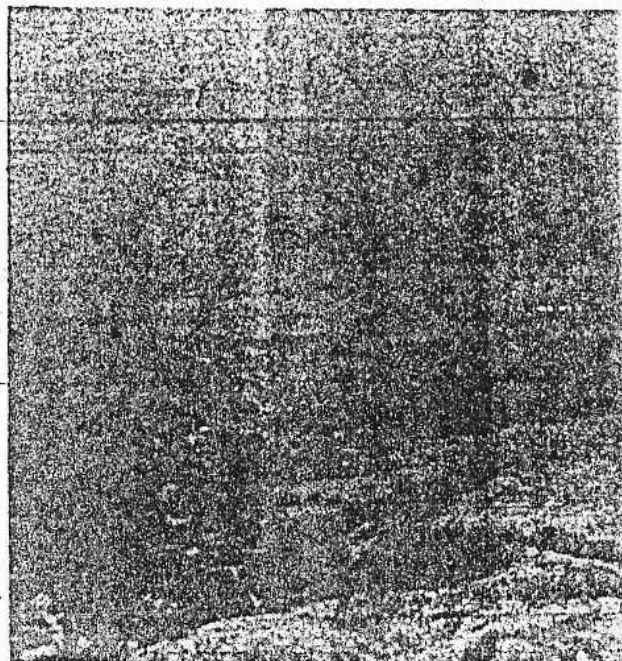
FACTORY JOB STILL IDLE

Power machinery is rapidly changing the appearance of two familiar spots of the Moore's lake landscape, where the first steps in the construction of a dam and spillway at the north end of the lake, and building of a headwork and flume opening at the southern tip have been nicely started. This is part of the Ford Motor Company's development here.

The Beutheln crane and bucket is pulling out muck and top soil, to get down to the hard pan at the lower end of the lake, and the shovel has been moved to the dam location above, where operations have been started.

Quite an activity has gotten under way at this point, where tool sheds and construction offices, etc., have been set up by W. H. Mueller, general contractor for building the dam. Machinery and chutes for cement work have also been placed, but pouring will await completion of the shovel work, probably some time next week.
