### **MILFORD COUPLE ATTEND RECEPTION FOR HENRY FORD**

Mr. and Mrs. F.S. Hubbell were among the "old friends" of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Ford who assembled at the Edison Institute near Greenfield Village Tuesday evening at a reception for the motor magnate and his wife, who are celebrating their golden wedding anniversary. Mr. Hubbell's acquaintance with Mr. Ford dates back almost half a century when the latter was an employee of the Detroit Edison Company, and fired the boilers in the old Edison plant in Detroit. Since that time they have continued the acquaintance-ship and it was through Mr. Hubbell that Mr. Ford became interested in acquisition of both the Pettibone and Huron waterpowers, and their subsequent development as now being carried out, came into being.

The invitation to the reception also included reservations for the night at the Dearborn Inn, where Mr. and Mrs. Hubbell stayed, returning to Milford Wednesday morning.
